I. GENERAL INFORMATION TO BIDDERS

1. The Bidders can download the e-Auction documents from the Portal: <https://haryanaeprocurement.gov.in>.
2. The intending bidders before participation in the Online Auction/ bidding process will be required to create their user account online by selecting the option of Auction from discipline column and obtain user-id/password on the website <https://haryanaeprocurement.gov.in> (If already created user account, this step needs to be skipped). For necessary instructions regarding participation in Online Auction please visit the aforementioned website and click on the available link “How to...” at the Home Page for their frequently asked queries (FAQs) regarding Online Bidding Process.
3. Intending bidders will be mandatorily required to sign-up online (create user account) by selecting discipline Auction on the website <https://haryanaeprocurement.gov.in> to be eligible to participate in the Online Auction. He/She will be required to make online payment of e-Service Fee & Participation Fees as per details provided in Page No. 1. The intended bidder who fails to pay e-Service Fee & Participation Fees under the stipulated time frame shall be restricted to participate under Online Auction.
4. The Bidders shall have to pay e-Service Fee & Participation Fees online by using the service of secure electronic payment gateway. The secure electronic payments gateway is an online interface between bidders and online payment authorization networks.
5. The payment for e-Service Charges shall be made by bidders online directly through Debit Cards & Internet Banking and the payment for Participation Fees can be made online directly through Debit Cards/InternetBanking or RTGS/NEFT. **Please refer to ‘Online Payment Guidelines’ available atAnnexure-I.**
- 6.The interested bidders shall have to pay mandatorily **e-Service fee of Rs. 1000/- (Rs. One Thousand only) (Non Refundable)** online by using the service of secure electronic gateway. 7. The payment of Participation Fees i.e. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) shall be made by bidders either online directly through Debit Cards/Internet banking/RTGS/NEFT.
 - a. 9 (a) Any bidder interested to participate in the Auction can submit his bid/s from (time) to (time)AM/ P.M. on (date).
 (b) However, in case any bid in respect of any buses/material is received 10 minutes prior to time fixed for the closer for the bid i.e. bid received between (time) P.M. to (time) P.M. and so on then the time of closer of the entire e-Auction in respect of all the Items/buses would be extended automatically by 20 minutes (as mentioned in Para 8 above), so that equal opportunity is made available to the persons participating in the bidding process.

 The above committee reserves the right to accept/reject any bid without assigning any reason thereof.
 In case of any dispute, the decision of Director, State Transport, Haryana will be final.

11.	Deposit of Sale value of Buses / materials:- The bidder whose highest bid has been accepted by State Transport, Haryana and has been issued acceptance letter will be required to deposit the total sale value of buses /material through RTGS/NEFT or Net banking or debit cards or through Demand Draft in favour of Director, State Transport Haryana within 10 working dates from the date of issue of acceptance letter in its/their favour.
12.	Deposit of G.S.T. @ notified by the Govt. or as applicable time to time:- The bidder whose highest bid has been accepted and has been issued acceptance letter will deposit G.S.T. @ notified by the Govt. or as applicable time to time of Sale Value of the buses/material through RTGS/NEFT or Net banking or debit cards or through Demand Draft issued in favour of Director, State Transport Haryana , payable at Chandigarh within 10 working days (between 09.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.) from the date of issue of acceptance letter in its/their favour.
13.	Release Order for buses/material:- On receipt of documentary proof of deposit of Sale Value of Buses/material and Deposit of G.S.T. @ notified by the Govt. or/and any other taxes as applicable time to time as stated in Para 11 and 12 above, the concerned General Manager, Haryana Roadways will issue releasing order for Buses/material to the purchaser(s) under intimation to this office. The selected bidder will have to lift the auctioned buses / material within 30 days from the date of issue of acceptance letter.
14.	Place of Delivery:- Consignee's site on "as is where is basis"& "as is what it is basis".
15.	G.S.T. @ notified by the Govt. or any other taxes as applicable time to time once deposited not be refunded under any circumstances.
16.	Retaining/Not Retaining of Registration No. of Buses:- It is the sole prerogative of the indenting department as to whether they will retain the Registration No. of the condemned buses mentioned in the list or allow to be transferred in the name of the bidder. (a) If State Transport, Haryana retains the Registration No. of the buses mentioned in the list then new number will be provided by the Transport Department (Regulatory Wing) at the time of transfer of the Registration Card (RC). (b) If State Transport, Haryana allows for transfer of the Registration No. of the Buses mentioned in the list to the bidder then bidder has to deposit the requisite Govt. Fees to the Transport Department (Regulatory Wing)for obtaining the particular number at the time of transfer of the Registration Card (RC).
17.	Refund of Participation Fees (EMD):-The same will be automatically refunded in the bidder's account as per details given below:- (a) In case of unsuccessful bidders (whose rates are not Highest), the Participation Fees (EMD) will be refunded within next 72 hours from the date of close of Online Auction automatically through electronic mode directly in their accounts as per details provided by them at the time of payment of Participation Fees (EMD). Annexure-I

Guidelines for Online Payments at e-Procurement Portal of Government of Haryana

Post registration, bidder shall proceed for bidding by using his Password. Bidder shall proceed to select the event he is interested in. On the respective Department's page in **the e-Procurement** portal, the Bidder would have following options to make payment for e-Service Fee & Participation Fees (EMD):-

- a. Debit Card – for e-Service Fee only
- b. Net Banking - for e-Service Fee only
- c. Net banking/NEFT–for Participation Fees (EMD) Only.
- d. Operative Procedures for Bidder Payments:-

A). Debit Card:- The procedure for paying through Debit Card will be as follows:-

- I. Bidder selects Debit Card option in e-Procurement portal.
- II. The e-Procurement portal displays the amount and the card charges to be paid by bidder. The portal also displays the total amount to be paid by the bidder.
- III. Bidder clicks on “Continue” button
- IV. The e-Procurement portal takes the bidder to Debit Card payment gateway screen.
- V. Bidder enters card credentials and confirms payment
- VI. The gateway verifies the credentials and confirms with “successful” or “failure” message, which is confirmed back to e-Procurement portal.
- VII. The page is automatically routed back to e-Procurement portal
- VIII. The status of the payment is displayed as “successful” in e-Procurement portal. The e-Procurement portal also generates a receipt for all successful transactions. The bidder can take a print out of the same,
- IX. The e-Procurement portal allows Bidder to process another payment attempt in case payments are not successful for previous attempt.

B). Net Banking:-The procedure for paying through Net Banking will be as follows.

- I. Bidder selects Net Banking option in e-Procurement portal.
- II. The e-Procurement portal displays the amount to be paid by bidder.
- III. Bidder clicks on “Continue” button
- IV. The e-Procurement portal takes the bidder to Net Banking payment gateway screen displaying list of Banks
- V. Bidder chooses his / her Bank
- VI. The Net Banking gateway redirects Bidder to the Net Banking page of the selected Bank
- VII. Bidder enters his account credentials and confirms payment
- VIII. The Bank verifies the credentials and confirms with “successful” or “failure” message to the Net Banking gateway which is confirmed back to e-Procurement portal.
- IX. The page is automatically routed back to e-Procurement portal
- X. The status of the payment is displayed as “successful” in e-Procurement portal. The e-Procurement portal also generates a receipt for all successful transactions. The bidder can take a print out of the same.
- XI. The e-Procurement portal allows Bidder to process another payment attempt in case payments are not successful for previous attempt.

C) RTGS/NEFT

The bidder shall have the option to make the Participation Fee (EMD) payment via Net banking as mentioned at point B. Also bidder shall have the option via RTGS/ NEFT. Using this

module, bidder would be able to pay from their existing Bank account through RTGS/NEFT. This would offer a wide reach for more than 90,000 bank branches and would enable the bidder to make the payment from almost any bank branch across India.

- I. Bidder shall log into the client e-procurement portal using user id and password as per existing process and selects the RTGS/NEFT payment option.
- II. Upon doing so, the e-procurement portal shall generate a pre-filled challan. The challan will have all the details that is required by the bidder to make RTGS-NEFT payment.
- III. Each challan shall therefore include the following details that will be pre-populated:
 - a. Beneficiary account no:(unique alphanumeric code for e-tendering)
 - b. Beneficiary IFSC Code:
 - c. Amount:
 - d. Beneficiary bank branch:
 - e. Beneficiary name:
- IV. The Bidder shall be required to take a print of this challan and make the RTGS/NEFT on the basis of the details printed on the challan.
- V. The bidder would remit the funds at least T + 1 day (Transaction + One day) in advance to the last day and make the payment via RTGS / NEFT to the beneficiary account number as mentioned in the challan.
- VI. Post making the payment, the bidder would require to login on the e-Tendering portal and go to the payment page. On clicking the EMD Verification” button, there would be a link for real time validation. On clicking the same, system would do auto validation of the payment made against EMD.
